Academy Children's Theatre Company Requirements:

Voice and Acting Technique Class

(Ages 8 – 18)

This combined class is specifically designed to help the student progress. The voice segment of the class is to enrich the sound and technique of the Musical Theatre singer. The Acting segment of the class will help develop the student's stage presence and confidence in dramatic delivery.

This class is offered at BAT in beginning and intermediate levels.

The Academy Company member must attend weekly scheduled rehearsals.

Rehearsals and technique classes are on Sunday afternoons from 1:00 – 4:30. The week prior to a performance there will be other mandatory dress and tech rehearsals times and dates TBA.

Ballet or Jazz

Ballet and Jazz both offer classical training for dance. Many times an actor or singer may be called upon to dance. These fundamental classes will help to prepare students for all roles in any given show.

Commitment

Two unexcused rehearsals will forfeit membership in the company. Excessive excused absences may result in loss of role or dismissal from the company.

Monthly tuition for ACT is \$100 plus the cost of the Technique class.
